#### Recommendations for use

Temperature: between  $+15^{\circ}$ C and  $+30^{\circ}$ C. The surface should be clean, dry, free of dust and grease. When applying, avoid touching the adhesive side of the tape to avoid affecting its performance. Apply pressure-sensitive tapes under maximum pressure to achieve the optimum pressure level. The indicated performance level is reached after an adhesion time of 24 hours at  $+23^{\circ}$ C.

### Storage and shelf life

Clean and dry in a well-ventilated area, preferably at a temperature between +10°C and +30°C. Stored under these
