
1. Introduction

The device is designed to measure the intensity of light, sound, the amount of alcohol in exhaled air.


3. Unit setup and operation

L - LCD display
M - Microphone
S - Light level sensor
U - Mouthpiece
W - Power on switch

- Turn on the power using the button on the panel.
- Set the function/range selector switch to the desired position. If the value of the measured signal is unknown, select the highest measurement range.
- Watch the input signal value.
- In case of breathalyzers mount mouthpiece and blow the air according to the manufacturer's instructions.
- To replace the battery open the battery cover by unscrewing the screws or loosening the latch, replace the battery, close the cover.

4. Precautions

- Use appropriate terminals, functions, and ranges for selected measurement.
- Do not use the device if it is damaged. Before using the device, inspect the housing. Check if it has no cracks or broken off pieces. Carefully check the insulation surrounding the connectors.
- Make sure the battery cover is closed and latched before operating the unit.
- Do not use the device if it works incorrectly. Protection may be impaired. If you are unsure whether the device is working correctly, take it to the service.
- Replace the battery with a new one or charge the battery if the display shows the battery low indicator.
- When servicing the unit, use only spare parts specified by the manufacturer.
- Never use the device in explosive environments, if it is not designed to work in such conditions.
- During measurement of light intensity there is a risk of burns by the hot lamp or by the lighting device housing.
- During measurement of sound level, there is a risk of hearing damage, wear suitable protection.
